Whereas, The City of Wetumpka and officials with Alabama Power have been in ongoing discussions, and proposals have been made regarding rectifying the violations to the Wetumpka Municipal Airport's navigable airspace.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that The City of Wetumpka is committed to protect the navigable airspace of its airport in any way legally possible. The City of Wetumpka resolves to take whatever steps are necessary to ensure the unfettered operation of aircraft at its airport.
